Crail Golfing Society was established on 23rd February 1786 by eleven local men in the Golf Hotel, which makes it the seventh oldest golf club in existence. The fact that their chosen public house also bore the name of their chosen sport suggests that golf was played in Crail for many years before the official formation of the Society.

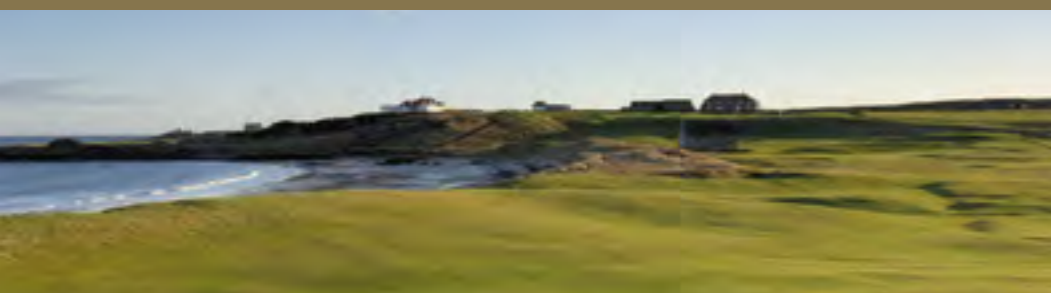
Initially, the Society played on the very narrow strip of land called Sauchope Links and originally played over eight holes, with some competitions comprising of three rounds and others of two. By the 1850's the Society occasionally played their competitions at Balcomie Links, depending on the condition of Sauchope and they shared this land with the 'East Neuk o' Fife Golf Club'. The two clubs amalgamated in 1894 and decided to contract Old Tom Morris to re-design the rudimentary course at Balcomie.

The Sauchope links continued to be used as a golf course, operated by the local council until the Second World War, when the Fleet Air Arm requisitioned the whole of the Fifeness peninsula for military use. After the war, due to the efforts of a dedicated few members, Balcomie was resurrected for golf and the Society returned to competitive golf. Sauchope is now a very popular and award winning caravan site and the airfield has long been abandoned by the military.

The North Sea has a massive influence on Balcomie Links and is never more than three hundred and fifty yards from any part of the course. It also provides the boundary for a third of the golf holes and the carry for the tee shots on the Fourth and Fifth holes owing to their 'dog-leg' design.

The third golf course to be built at Fifeness is the Craighead Links, designed by Gil Hanse and opened in 1998. This latest addition to the Society's facilities is almost one thousand yards longer than Balcomie and was designed to meet the challenge of the modern golf game. Situated to the immediate west of Balcomie, Craighead commands panoramic views of the Isle of May and the Lothian coast and contains the scheduled ancient monument know as 'The Danes Dyke'. This substantial defensive wall was built by invading Germanic tribes to protect Fifeness harbour and provides a unique challenge on Craighead as it snakes through the course.
